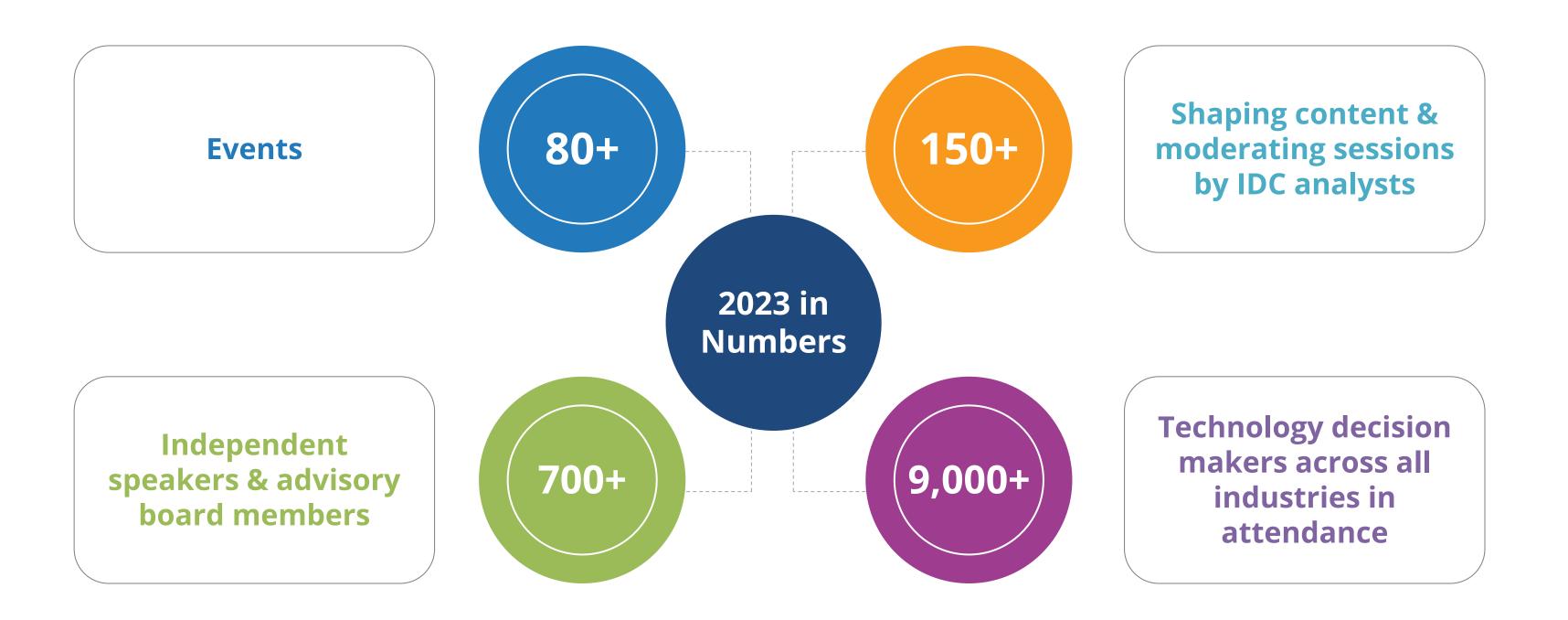

Evolving Threats, Advanced Defenses: Cybersecurity in the Next Era

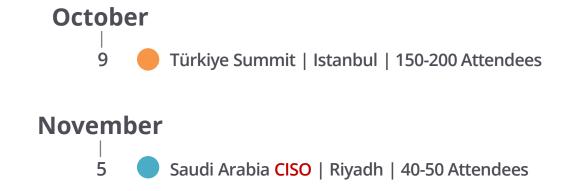

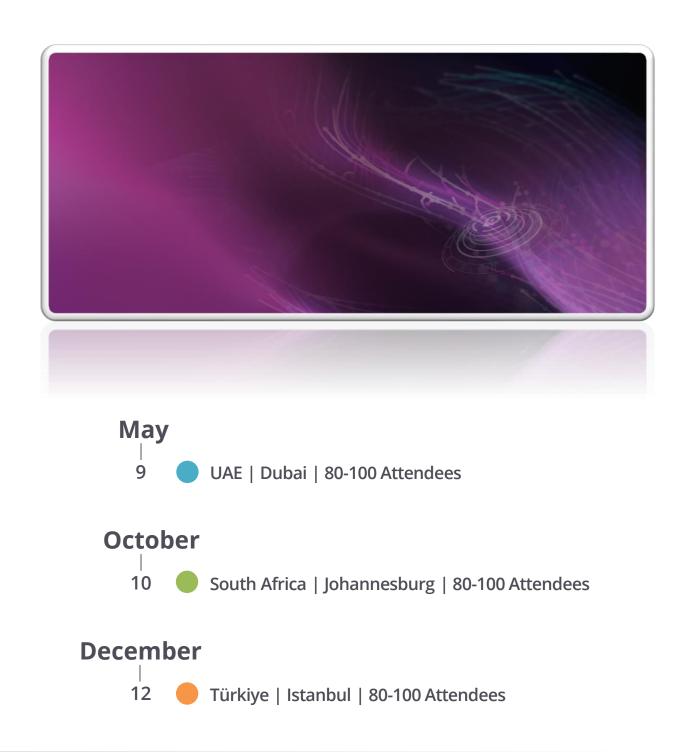

Developing Digital Agility and Resilience Through Enterprise Intelligence

The pandemic quicky revealed that our current systems are not as resilient as we thought they were. Artificial intelligence proved to be a solution to many real-life problems, which did not go unnoticed among businesses.

This is expected to lead to huge opportunities for AI in the future, spanning used cases such as improved response to unpredictable, improved shipping and asset management, faster and broader analysis of healthcare systems, and image and video recognition in areas like security and ecommerce.

In Europe the Middle East, and Africa (EMEA), the total value of the AI market will exceed \$200 billion in 2026. It will break through the \$100 billion mark in 2023 and will then double over the following three years (2024, 2025, and 2026 combined). Services will remain the fastest growing category, with a CAGR of 27.4%. Software grew substantially slower in EMEA, with a CAGR of 17.5%, while hardware's forecast CAGR is 15.4%.
